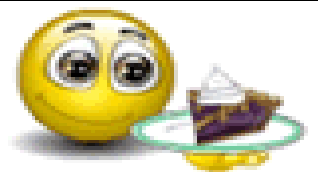

On May 25th Burnaby Central is hosting "Beyond Coding Workshop".








