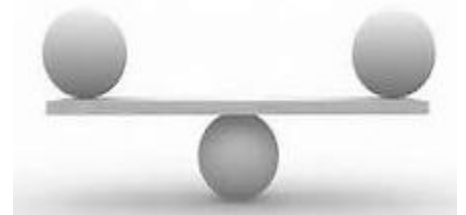

- ☯ Balance is the word of the New Year. We all NEED more balance, so come out and start the year knowing how to find it for yourself



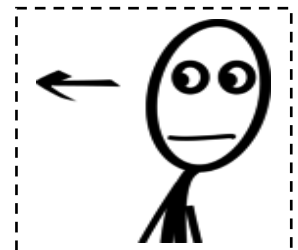

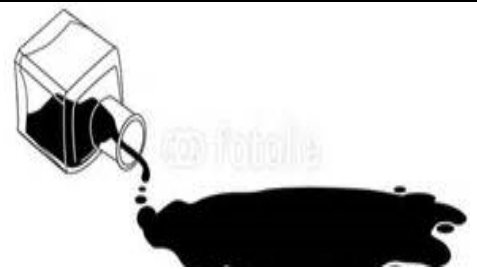


