
European/Art History Trip 2017




Euro/Art History Trip Objectives:

Payment Options

Automatic Monthly Payment Plans

- \$15 non-refundable deposit (and optional travel protection plus) paid upon registration
- Billed automatically to your credit card or chequing account
- Auto-withdrawals on either the 5th or 20th of the month
- Balance divided into equal monthly payments until 35 days prior to departure with your chequing account.
- Only on credit cards until 65 days prior to departure.

Manual Payment Plan – 3 step (Payments are <u>not</u> automatically withdrawn)


- \$15 non-refundable deposit (and optional travel protection plus) paid upon registration

Security Information:


Travelers will be placed in pods. Travelers <u>ALWAYS</u> check in and check out with their pod supervisor. Participants must always have a hotel card with them. Passports will be carried by pod leaders until the final 'leg' of the journey when they will be returned. Tickets are handled in the same fashion.

Cash can also be carried by the pod-leader. Cash should be placed in a clearly labeled 'zip-lock' type bag with the participants name on it. Make sure you have a money carrier. Nothing goes into your pockets.



Rooms:

Grouping for rooming accommodations will be made for 2, 3 and 4. These have to be flexible as the pattern of room allocations are often changed at each hotel (from doubles to triples) and are nonnegotiable. Students can speak to their pod leader if they have a problem with their roommates.
