SCOPE AND SEQUENCE FOR COMPLETION

Students have 3 years to complete their Graduation Transitions. During that time three components focusing on Personal Health, Community Connections and Career & Life must be completed.

This process starts in Planning 10 and is completed in Grade 12 with the Exit Interview. In order to help students to achieve this we have put in place a scope and sequence for its completion. This chart will help to ensure that students have completed the aspects necessary and will be the basis for a comment on their progress that must be given on a report card in Grade 11.

SCOPE AND SEQUENCE FOR COMPLETION

Grade 10 – Planning 10	
By the end of Grade 10 students should have completed a minimum of the following:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Career Research Project • Financial Plan • Health Project • Graduation Planner • Summary (Prep for Capstone) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal Healthy Living Plan • Log of 150 minutes per week moderate to vigorous physical activity • Resume, Cover Letter • Worksafe Unit- 80% on exam
Grade 11	
By the end of Grade 11 students should have completed a minimum of the following:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log of 150 minutes per week moderate to vigorous physical activity 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30 hours work experience or community experience
Grade 12	
By the end of Grade 12 students should have completed a minimum of the following:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log of 150 minutes per week moderate to vigorous physical activity • updated resume 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exit Interview - March 6(PM) or April 26(AM),2018 • Grade 12 Transition Plan (with Attachments – DUE January 12th ,2017)

Students planning on completing components of Graduation Transitions in various classes in their grade 12 year must be aware that the completion must be done before they participate in the Student Led Interview. Completion of a component cannot rely on the completion of a course because the Exit Interview will take place before the end of Grade 12 and their course work does not end until June of their Grade 12 year.
