

We are looking forward to seeing our students back at school starting tomorrow Thursday September 10 & 11 for our student orientation days. Please remember the following information that was part of our back to school start up plan. We are working really hard to maintain health and safety measures this year and need us all to work together for success.

Courses

IMPORANT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS- Please Read Carefully

Counsellors cannot meet with students or parents in-person regarding course requests at this time; please do not come to Student Services without an appointment. ***Students with personal or mental-health concerns are welcome to visit their counsellor; please wear your mask!*** (عز)

There are still some small changes being made in the timetable, so please be sure to **check your timetable again on Thursday morning before attending your first class.**

With the exception of timetable errors, **we are unable to accommodate course change requests for Quarter 1** at this time. Timetable errors include:

- Your schedule is **incomplete**, i.e. one or more courses is missing from your timetable
- You were placed in the **incorrect grade level** of a course (ex. English 12 instead of English 11)
- You have a **double** of a course in your timetable (ex. Science 9 appears twice)

Masks

Please arrive at the school with your mask. Students will be receiving two (2) reusable masks in their period 1 class during the student orientation days.

Driveway and Traffic

If you drive your students to school you may have noticed that there is often a significant traffic jam near the school entrance and our driveway. We respectfully ask that you do the following:

- 1) Drop your students off down on Eastlake or in the Cul de Sac below the school entrance.
- 2) Do not drop students off on the ascending part of the driveway or on the inside lane of the drive as this can be very dangerous.
- 3) Encourage your kids to walk to school when possible.

Please help us to keep the driveway clear for the arrival of our two school buses bringing our special needs students and for district staff and deliveries.

Daily Health Check

When parents/guardians accompany their child(ren) to the school, or when your child(ren) arrive(s) unattended at the school, you or your child will be asked the following questions each day prior to being admitted.

If your child answers 'yes' to any of the questions without an asterisk, they will not be allowed to attend that day and they will have to return home and remain home until they can answer 'no' to those questions. See below for managing 'yes' responses for questions with an asterisk.

If a student is ill with any common cold, influenza or COVID-19 like symptoms, they must stay home and either isolate for 10 calendar days following onset of symptoms, or until symptoms resolve. Contact 8-1-1 for guidance if you are unsure of the symptoms or access the online COVID-19 Assessment Tool at <https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en>. If returning before 10 days, provide a medical note.

** If a child is presenting baseline symptoms such as seasonal allergies please contact administration for further guidance.

*** Students may still attend school if a member of their household has cold, influenza, or COVID- 19-like symptoms, provided the students is asymptomatic and is cleared by a health care provider.
