September 2021 Back to School Plan

Dear Burnaby Mountain Families:

Welcome back! We are all excited about the return to school, but we also fully understand that there is still some uncertainty and apprehension out there. This document is meant to answer as many of your questions as we can.

The first day of school for students is Tuesday, September 7th.

Health and Safety

We are working under the guidance of public health authorities and the Ministry of Education to develop a plan so that students and staff can learn and work together safely. We are ready to welcome your child back to school on September 7th. Some of the many actions taken to safely restart school this September include:

- Daily health screening checks for students and staff before arriving at school. (A copy of the Health Assessment is available on the school website).
- Students who are ill (cold, flu or showing Covid-19 symptoms) must stay home. If a student becomes ill during the school day parents will be contacted to come and pick them up as soon as possible.
- There will be enhanced cleaning protocols in place.
- Teachers will be encouraged to take their class outside more frequently where appropriate.
- All students are required to wear a mask or face shield indoors, in schools and on school buses with some exceptions (for example: eating and drinking, vigorous physical activity, playing the trumpet).
- No sharing of food or drink.
- All visitors must sign in and wear a non-medical mask when inside the school. Parents are asked to book an appointment or reach out to school staff by phone, virtual meeting or email.
 - Staff and students will also be asked to use the hand sanitizer stations located at the entrance doors before entering the building and frequent handwashing is encouraged throughout the day.
 - All students will participate in a safety orientation on the first day of school.
 - Burnaby Mountain has an HVAC system with Merv 13 filters.

Student Orientation Days and Times

- All students will be scheduled for a safety and school orientation to take place on September 7th.
- Students will report to their Period 1 class to receive this orientation and then will be dismissed.

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- These information sessions will cover the safety protocols for our school, explain our new timetable and schedule and student photo information, so that students arrive on September 8th prepared to safely begin their classes.
- Student timetables will be available through MyEdBC on the afternoon of Friday, September 3rd. Student MyEd accounts will not be available until then.
- **Grade 8 and all new students will receive an email with log in instructions and passwords for MyEdBC on (Friday, September 3) to ensure that they are able to access their [MyEdBC](#) accounts.**
- **Grade 8's will meet in Gym 2 and be escorted to their classes by their period one teacher.**

School Entrance for Students

Students are asked to do their daily health check, enter the building from their assigned door to ensure that we can maintain social distancing protocols. Students are asked to use the exit doors nearest their classroom and on the same floor to leave when their class is over.

Period 1 First Floor Classes - 100 level classrooms, Gym	Students will enter the doors in the parking lot under the yellow outside stairs
Period 1 Second Floor Classes – 200 level classrooms	Students will enter the main doors off of Eastlake by the rainbow crosswalk.
Period 1 Third Floor Classes – 300 level classrooms	Students will enter the doors off of Gaglardi nearest to the cafeteria

- Each teacher will inform his/her students about supply requirements for his/her specific course.
- Students should arrive at their first class with a binder and pen or pencil.
