Programs: Wednesdays at Forest Grove Elementary Cooking Classes – 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm Fridays at Forest Grove Garden Club – 3 pm to 4:30 PM – all year. Garden Club duties include: Supervision and Support with children ranging from 7 to 13 yrs old; Ensuring children are using garden tools and kitchen tools properly; Helping with garden tasks such as planting, weeding, watering, and possibly building trellis structures. You will learn as you go about what seeds need to grow, managing existing plants, and when to plant for most effective results using organic methods. As a holistic nutritional student, your knowledge of conscious eating habits and the health benefits of eating foods growing in the gardens will be highly valued. Cooking Classes duties include: washing dishes and supervising students in small groups while preparing and cooking food.
