2. Minutes of May 2024 Council Meeting

4. Treasurer's Report (Jay) Main Operating Account

- Cash is Main account as at April 30, 2024 → is \$4,142
- In the month of May we received \$6,798 funds for a Raffel draw and we issued a cheque for \$4,285 to the winner. We are advised that more funds are expected to be received from the Raffel company.
- We issued a check for teacher's appreciation lunch of \$1426.

Gaming Account

- Cash in gaming account as of April 30, 2024, → is 25,166.
 - o Two cheques were cashed in the Month of May
 - We have received reimbursement request 1 from the school of \$6,551 for school Wish list.

- We have received reimbursement request 2 from the school of \$3,404 for school Wish list.
- We will issue a payment of \$5000 for 10 scholarships from the funds held with the school PAC Account.
- We have received a request of \$12,121 for the 3rd and the final gaming request.
- We have issued 2 cheques to support 2 sports teams. One for Track team for \$600 and one for Ultimate team for \$1500.
